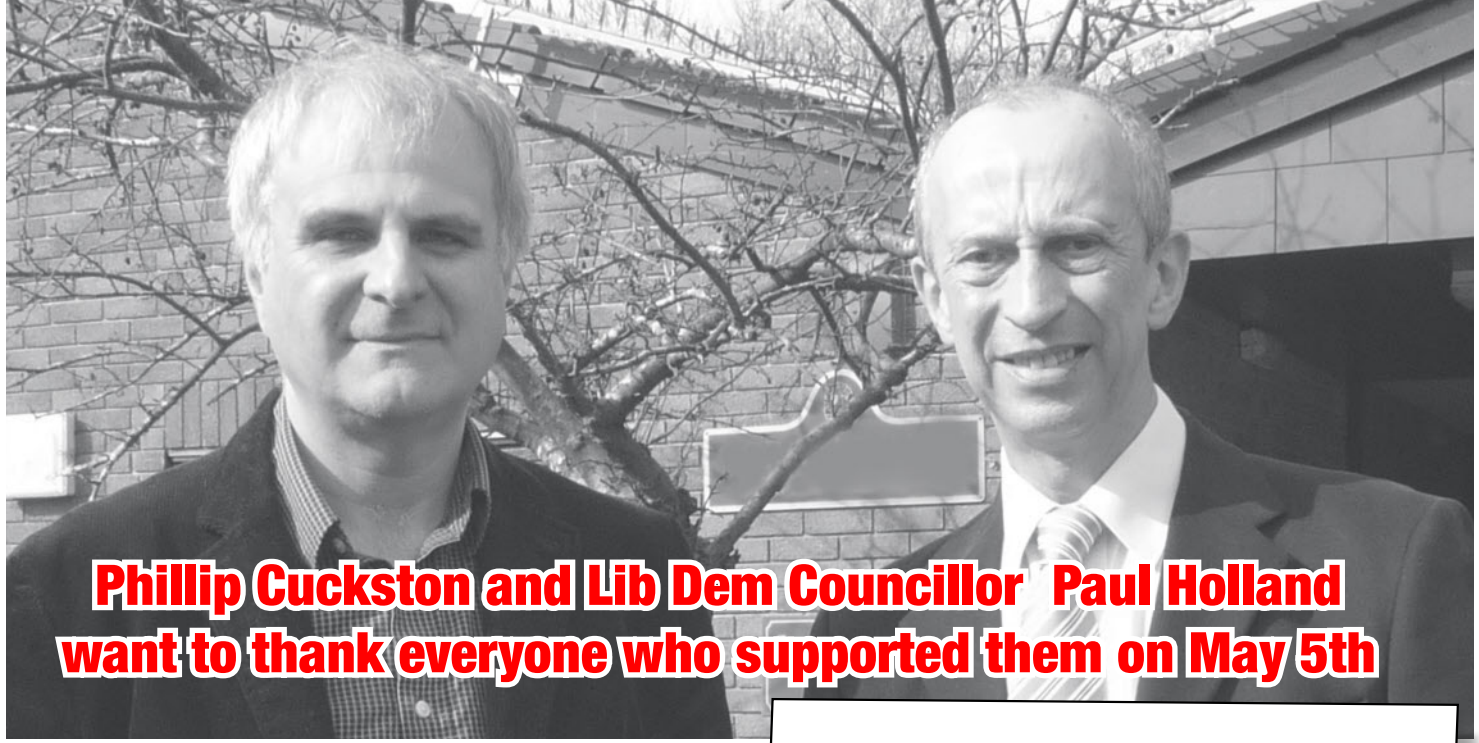

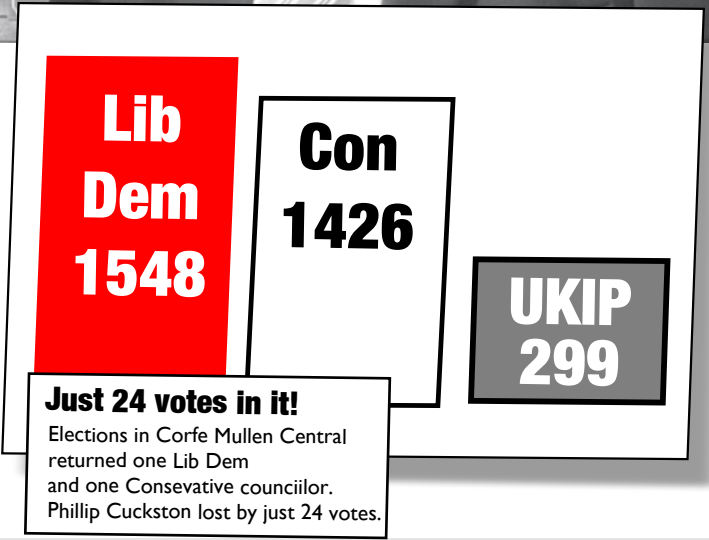


**Phillip Cuckston and Lib Dem Councillor Paul Holland want to thank everyone who supported them on May 5th**

# Corfe Mullen Library Saved for Second Time

Your Lib Dem team were delighted by the news that Corfe Mullen Library was to be reprieved at the full County Council meeting held on 21st July.

Sadly nine community libraries will have their funding withdrawn despite the efforts of your local Lib Dems. Annette Brooke MP and County Councillor Susan Jefferies spoke out against the proposals at the meeting,

arguing against the cuts in the service.

Cllr Susan Jefferies commented, "Whilst I am really happy that our local library has been saved, it was sad to see that most of the Conservatives were unwilling to look at other options for savings.

Corfe Mullen is safe for the moment, however we could well have another round of cuts in three

or four years time. If any of the smaller libraries become successful community run libraries then this model may well be extended to others."

Annette Brooke MP added, "With the need to improve our children's literacy skills it is a nonsense to close libraries when Dorset could make management savings and efficiencies in book purchasing."
